1	Welcome/ Apologies	HT Welcomed all to new online PC forum using Webex.	
2	HT Update	HT update was shared with PC prior to meeting and is attached as a separate document. Comments from HT/PC are captured below:  Planning for Recovery – issues discussed  Blended Model  LMc shared that there is parental awareness around a blended curriculum in the TMPS community.  Lunches  KM – impact on school lunches – how will that look?  COVID-19  LA – symptoms in children. HT shared COVID-19 risk assessment in place in Hub. Clear communication and protocol in place. Two isolation rooms in school. Messages about collective social responsibility  Childcare Provision  LL – EDC provision for childcare?  Bishopbriggs Afterschool provision – how will that operate?  Classification  No reclassification  LMc – key protective factor is friendships for settling back to school.  Collective viewpoint of PC – that parents will be less anxious if children are happy with key friendship groups.  Uniforms/Equipment  HT confirmed that children will be advised to wear comfortable uniform (no shirts and tie) and will need wellies/waterproofs.

3	Home Learning	HT asked for feedback from PC:  LA – lots of choice at the moment – more targeted focus in new blended model would be good.  LM – P1/P2 adult input is high – can be a barrier to access – can more tasks be independent (audio/Visual)  Action  Feedback to class teachers in P1/P2
		P1 transitions – J Law is calling all new P1 families Stage to stage – transition booklets have been completed and
		staff have made bios for children who will be in their new class.
4	Transitions	Weekly check ins with vulnerable children have been on-going during school closure and PSG (Pupil Support Groups) have continued fortnightly using virtual platform.
		Enhanced transitions – TMPS will use Inset Days to support.
5	Next Steps – key issues raised.	Class teachers/Bubbles/Days – when will they be confirmed TMPS has a provisional overview (deadline next week). Some year groups will be split 4 ways to allow for smaller bubbles. Aim by end of June to have it finalised.  Staggered Starts/Breaks/End of Day This is being planned for – thinking of how P1 model will look P2-P7 – potentially a drop and go model.  ASN children may need alternative plan.  No confirmation on buses.  Need to co-ordinate with Cleddens nursery  Reports Currently not being issued at the moment.  PC asked HT to speak to Greg Bremner – they are aware other authorities have issued reports.  IS – key to get reports to P7 families.  Action  HT/SLT to liaise with Cleddens for joint planning for entries at grounds.  HT to speak to GB around reports
