1.	Welcome/Apologies	
2.	Head Teacher Update - AGM	<ul> <li>Ana Trindade confirmed as chair</li> <li>Darren McNichol confirmed as vice-chair</li> <li>Marie Claire Cairns confirmed as secretary</li> </ul>
3.	Head Teacher Update - Staffing	<ul> <li>7 teachers on maternity leave</li> <li>2 more maternity leaves planned to start during this academic year</li> <li>Aiming to make some temporary staff permanent</li> <li>Megan Jones confirmed as permanent 3<sup>rd</sup> depute – dedicated to P6 and P7</li> <li>Heidi Cochrane acting PT</li> <li>Await backfill for Megan's role</li> <li>High turnover of support staff too – 3 retirements, with 2 replacements started already</li> </ul>
4.	Head Teacher Update - Outdoor area/Playground update	<ul> <li>Issue was water collecting both in trim trail and grassed area. Latter was reseeded.</li> <li>Repair works were scheduled for start of summer holidays but didn't happen - now aiming for October week</li> <li>Aside - MUGA = Multi Use Games Area</li> </ul>
5.	Head Teacher Update - Meet the teacher feedback	<ul> <li>Parent feedback was that sessions should/coulld be staggered for parents with multiple children in different</li> </ul>



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		<ul> <li>classes. Alternative is to run 7x3=21 sessions on consecutive afternoons?</li> <li>Other feedback was the format was more geared towards seeing the child in their learning environment than meeting the teacher?</li> <li>Consider teacher introduction at the start of the session</li> <li>Rebrand for next year – less emphasis on the meet the teacher part</li> <li>Noted that there are other opportunities to meet the teacher too, e.g. come read with me sessions Request for more notice next time</li> <li>Suggestion to hold it in the same week of the year each year and include in dates for diary</li> </ul>
6.	Head Teacher Update - Parent/Carer Appointments	<ul> <li>Only change – parent to book times via online Parent Portal</li> <li>Noted some parents are experiencing a delay in "verification"</li> <li>Follow up communication to be issued clarifying when the appointments booking will go live</li> <li>Aside - Appointments will be held on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> October</li> </ul>
7.	Head Teacher Update - Dogs in the playground	<ul> <li>Complaints from parents that dogs are being observed frequently in the playground</li> <li>Not acceptable due to allergies and children simply being scared of dogs</li> <li>In addition, recent spate of dog attacks in the news</li> </ul>
8.	Head Teacher Update - Crossing patrol and general traffic issues	<ul> <li>Noted that parking is as bad as ever</li> <li>Total disregard for parking restrictions</li> <li>Repeat daily offenders noted</li> <li>Discussed repeating communication to parents</li> <li>Noted that St Dominic's car park is always available for use, despite them receiving abuse from parents</li> <li>Discussed other options such as additional signage</li> <li>Noted that this topic is discussed at every parent council meeting, yet the problem doesn't improve</li> </ul>
9.	Air quality/filter systems	<ul> <li>Parent James McDonald gave an overview of clean air in schools</li> <li>Compared the quality of air in most office environments to schools – essentially much cleaner, and with multiple benefits, both transmission of illnesses and improved cognitive performance</li> <li>Government discussions not scheduled until next year, which means the funding is even further away</li> <li>Ideal solution is to add HEPA filters to air conditioning system and increase ventilation – but it's expensive</li> <li>Alternative solution (~10% of the cost) is a standalone unit that is simply plugged in, filters on 4 sides, exceeds performance of HEPA filters in ceiling</li> <li>Noise output expected to be minimal</li> </ul>



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10.	Twitter update – Megan Jones	<ul> <li>12-month lifetime. Unit cost is around £100, approx. 1 per classroom would be required</li> <li>Noted that EDC would have to pursue an initiative like this</li> <li>Noted that the CO2 performance of the school is good, suggesting decent ventilation or at least circulation of air with the open plan layout</li> <li>Worth finding out if the school already has HEPA filters?</li> <li>Noted that this would not necessarily be a parent council topic, more a council or national initiative, however parent feedback worthwhile</li> <li>Darren will raise this at the joint parent councils meeting</li> <li>James could raise it with the councillors</li> <li>Agreed to revisit the topic at the next meeting</li> <li>Teething problems getting all parents back following the newly <i>private</i> page - Close to being resolved</li> <li>Exceptions highlighted – applications from grandparents, local community leaders, etc.</li> </ul>
11.	Window cleaning	<ul> <li>Unanimous agreement that only parents and teachers should be granted access</li> <li>Check with facilities management about frequency of cleaning (speculation that they've never been</li> </ul>
		cleaned?)
12.	Uniform	<ul> <li>Noted that kids are wearing inappropriate clothing on PE days and not conforming to the uniform guidelines</li> </ul>
13.	Timing of bells	<ul> <li>Noted the ring is actually at 9:02am and 3:02pm</li> <li>Some teachers had also noticed – to be raised with facilities</li> </ul>
